38 TOTAL RESPONSES, 53% FROM THE U.S.

- **A MAJORITY OF RESPONDENTS REPORT THAT THEIR GREATEST CONCERN FROM FOREIGN COMPETITION IS FROM FOREIGN ADVANTAGE IN LABOR AND RAW MATERIALS.**
- **RESPONDENTS REPORT THAT COST CUTTING INITIATIVES AND REINVESTMENT IN MODERN PLANT EQUIPMENT ARE THE MOST COMMON ATTEMPTS TO COUNTERACT FOREIGN COMPETITION.**
- **FEW RESPONDENTS SAY THEY ARE IN GREAT DANGER AND ARE LIKELY TO CLOSE IN THE NEXT FIVE YEARS SOLELY FROM FOREIGN COMPETITION.**
